WARREN

Likable if a bit neurotic. Doesn't want to disappoint anyone so he's always getting too far out of the way - even when his presence is needed.

SUNNY

Sunny needs to stop putting everybody else's happiness before her own. She suppresses her Vermont accent except when she gets very emotional.

WARREN & SUNNY

They are very much in love from the start. They are incapable of having kids; this is known. This trauma informs a lot of their neuroses. They love their chick-a-were-babies.

FLETCHER

Smarmy, manic, damaged. Not two-faced; more like five-faced.

GEORGIA

20-something. Pragmatic. Speaks (as if) from the brain. Skeptical about rural VT. Person of color.

SHARON

20-something. Inspirational. Speaks from the heart. Curious and eager to learn about rural Vermont.

CHESTER

Fastidious, duty-bound. Clueless but country wise. Sincerely committed to his job.

ADDISON

Brash and brassy. It's how she shields herself from the risks that come with making real connections with others. She is not good at making room for other people. She finishes others' sentences ... incorrectly.

CHELSEA, CLARENDON, AND CHARLOTTE (Werehens)

Being a werehen adds a layer of crankiness, selfishness, and cruelty to one's existing personality (Warren included). After they're killed, they exist as ghosts and, thus, not visible to the living.

CHELSEA

Crone werehen. Seen way too much in her 400+ years.

CLARENDON

Mother werehen. Fletcher's mom. She hates that she has to spend eternity hanging around Chelsea.

CHARLOTTE

Maiden werehen. Mischievous. Was turned into a werehen at a young impressionable age.

MORGAN, MONTGOMERY, MILTON (Chick-a-were-babies)

Punks. Depraved on account of they're deprived.

They are literal reincarnations of the werehens so they should be played by the same actors.

SMALL ROLES (actors can take on multiple roles, if desired)

DERBY & DORSET

Lumberjills. Longtime friends of Addison.

ANNOUNCER

Local yokel with a very strong accent.

JOGGER

Runner's high junky. Annoyingly happy.

DOG

Very happy to be wherever he or she is.

IRA WESTMORE

He sure loved his horse, Rupert. Sad about Rupert.

JAY

Fletcher's dad.
